Dear Chris:

On September 30, 2008, stakeholders met to review the proposal presented by MyBillofRights.Org and Rhode Partners, pursuant to HCR 111, to display and honor our national Bill of Rights at the Texas Capitol on the plaza in front of the Supreme Court building. This letter confirms that the Texas Facilities Commission (TFC) and our tenants, (the Supreme Court and the Court of Criminal Appeals) are in agreement and would like to move forward on the development of this plaza-wide proposal. This does not constitute an approval of the existing plan, but we have no objection to MyBillofRights.Org initiating fundraising and/or publicly releasing the current architectural drawings, with the provision that this release stipulates that the design be described as schematic, not final, with specific landscape elements and other compatibility requirements contingent upon ongoing review.
